ACTION: Ask for volunteers for set-up and clean-up for 12/22 Potluck. (Pat Young has volunteered for this date. Additional helpers needed).

ACTION: Minute the following future Intergenerational Programs and Potluck;

- 1) request volunteers to take the lead on organizing the Potlucks
- 2) Request volunteers to help with the children's activity following the Faith and Play story.
This is usually about 30-40 minutes. For child safety we must always have two adults with the children.
